- Featured program regarding the key work of School Boards, presented by the Maryland Association of Boards of Education. School boards do a better job when they are challenged and supported by an informed and involved community. This presentation will describe how a local school board functions and define the specific roles and responsibilities of a local school board and its members. As an organization devoted to the well being of all children and youth, the PTA provides parents, teachers, and students the means to participate and work effectively with the school board. At the same time, the PTA helps the school board to be informed about the community and the needs of children. This partnership improves the quality of education.
