PTA Council grants two special scholarships:

- The Georgie Clevenger Memorial Scholarship for a graduating BCPS senior planning on a career in nursing
- *New this year:* **The Marilyn Ryan Memorial Scholarship** for a graduating BCPS senior with exceptional volunteering or public service

Please ensure that the application is filled out in its entirety and submit all required information, including required signatures, by the **postmarked deadline of April 30, 2021.**

The Scholarship Committee will select recipients in May 2021, and will notify the recipient, school principal, and sponsoring PTA. Checks (made payable to the academic institution) will be presented at Senior Awards Nights where applicable.

Upon meeting the following criteria, eligible applicants must:

- be a high school senior in a BCPS school
- be a member of a PTA Council of Baltimore County local unit meeting the Standards of Continuing Affiliation (in "good standing")
- obtain sponsorship of a PTA Council of Baltimore County local PTA in good standing
- complete application with all required signatures
- forward completed application packet by April 30, 2021 to:

- c) Has bylaws approved every three (3) years according to the procedures of Maryland PTA;
- d) Has a minimum of twenty-five (25) members;
- e) Shall submit the name and contact information including phone number, address and e-mail address of all elected officers to the MDPTA office within two (2) weeks of their election;
- f) Remits bonding, liability and directors' and officers' insurance premiums by the date designated;
- g) Has an Employer Identification Number (EIN) from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) on file with Maryland PTA;
- h) Maintains its status as a corporation, has, as required by MD non-profit law, at a minimum a president, a secretary and treasurer;
- i) Files the appropriate tax forms, by the required dates, with the IRS and submits a copy to the Maryland PTA office within thirty (30) days of filing;
- j) Each local PTA shall submit a copy of its annual financial review, to Maryland PTA within one hundred (120) days following the end of the local's fiscal year;
- k) Files all appropriate state forms with the appropriate state authorities by the required date and submits a copy to the Maryland PTA office within 30 days of filing.
